Hello Starlight Ranch Residents!

If you know any of our seasonal residents please be a good friend and keep an eye on their homes when they are not there. Let someone know if you see anything that looks like there may be a problem. If it looks like a breakin, call the police! If you notice cars parked there that don't seem like they should be there, let the management or a board member know so it can be checked into.

One of the things that a sheriff told us in a crime prevention meeting was the best thing people in a community like this can do is to for each other is to try to know and be a friend with the residents that live next door to them on all sides. We all know that is not always easy since there are people that just don't want to talk or be friendly (easier to just avoid them), but what he was saying was the more we look out for each other the safer our community will be.

One of the biggest complaints we get on the board is: "Why are all of the people that are not old enough for an age qualified community or are not registered renters at the office living here?" If you feel that someone is living next door to you that does not seem to fit into one of these categories; file the proper paper work with the management and get a signed and dated copy of the complaint form.

We have learned with our past dealings with this

situation that some people are a bit uncomfortable going to the office or just feel they are wasting their time, so we have set up a program for a board member to help out with filing the management paperwork and taking care of the follow up. We can also keep your complaint anonymous. Once in awhile we find out that it is not what it looks like when we know the whole story or we even find out there are additional rules we didn't know about.

This all "kinda comes down" to what I started out with here...the more we know about who lives next door and the more we look out for each other, the safer our community will be. Something else we are going to be doing very soon is going door to door to canvas the community to verify our resident list. We especially want to clear up some of the misleading information about our HOA so that everyone knows what our true fiduciary responsibilities are...for you...the residents.


