

RESIDENT COMPLAINT FORMS PROCEDURE

We are compiling a list of all complaints to be addressed by ELS. If you have a complaint (past and current) not completed by ELS turn them into Georgia to add to the list which will be presented to ELS Management. The list is reviewed with Dave (Park Manager) once a month. If you would like to remain anonymous you can fill out the date, leave the top blank and no signature is needed. Put your lot # on the back so the HOA can contact you and drop it off at the HOA office in the back clubhouse. You can slide it under the door or drop it off during office hours on Thursday and Sunday from 2-3 PM. You can also put the complaints in the suggestion box in the front clubhouse. We are also looking for information to identify unauthorized residents and children living in the park. Complaints are being tracked to create a paper trail to make ELS responsible to correct these issues. Please help the HOA make your community a nice safe place to live.



Jackie was born in Rochester, N.H. in 1933. She had two brothers and three sisters. Both brothers were also in the Navy. Jackie enlisted in 1954. She did Boot Camp in Bainbridge, Maryland. This was the only female boot camp at that time. After that she was transferred for duty at Great Lakes in Illinois. Worked for the Commanding Officer of Service School Command. She was discharged in 1956 and then went to work for the Civil Service. First place they sent her was to Downey's Veteran's Hospital in the records department. Then she was transferred back to Great Lakes at the mobilization team division office.

GLAMPING: If we only had lots of money!

Camping in the wild with all the comforts of a deluxe hotel, including real beds and plush furnishings? Now known as glamping – short for glamorous camping – has exploded. The camps offer convenient access to nature, without an investment in equipment or the chores of gathering firewood, sleeping in the rain, or waking up cold. The Resort of *Paws Up* in Montana erected fancy tents with framed art on the canvas walls, rugs on the wood floors, and introduced glamping's first three-bedroom, two-bath tents last summer. *Glamping.com* has over 800 locations worldwide, including lodges, tree houses, and cabins. Collective *Governors Island* will feature a car-free island in New York Harbor once it's fully open in July. This camp will have its own restaurant, offer message services, and equip some with their own bathrooms. Others will share facilities, but will have furnished porches. *Under Canvas* offers glamping resorts near national parks. Last month, it opened *Under Canvas* Rushmore in South Dakota. This solar-powered forest compound of 80 four-person tents, each with a wood stove and attached bathrooms, offers views of Mount Rushmore. On the Hudson River in Kingston, NY, *Terra Glamping* will open this month at Hutton Brickyards, on the river. Guests can borrow bikes, kayaks, and stand-up paddleboards, as well as lanterns and flashlights after dark.
