
RESIDENT COMMENT FORMS

Georgia has a monthly meeting with Dave (Starlight Manger) to review each comment form. If you would like to remain anonymous you can fill out the date, leave the top blank and no signature is needed. Put your lot # on the back so the HOA can contact you and drop it off at the HOA office in the back clubhouse. You can slide it under the door or drop it off during office hours on Thursday and Sunday from 2 - 3 PM. You can also put the Comment form in the suggestion box in the front clubhouse.
