Requesting Accesswith a Visitor Call

- Navigate to Resident Directory using Navigation keys.
- Scroll through the alphabet to the first letter of the last name.
- Press Enter.
- Scroll through name list to desired entry.
- Press Enter to call.
- The system dials the resident's telephone number to establish 2-way communications.
- The resident's telephone number will never be displayed to the visitor.
- If the resident is using the telephone at the same time a visitor calls, the display will indicate to the visitor that the line is busy.
- The resident answers the call and converses with the visitor to determine if access will be granted.
- Theresident can use their telephone's keypad by pressing 9. After access is granted, the system will disconnect the visitor and resident call.
- The resident can disconnect the visitor without granting access by pressing * or by hanging up

Solicitar acceso con la llamada de un visitante

- Navegue aldirectorio residente usando las teclas de navegación.
- Desplazarse/buscarpor el alfabeto la primera letra del apellido.
- Presione Entrar.
- Desplazarse/buscapror la lista la primera letra del nombres hasta la entrada deseada.
- El sistema marca el numero de telefono delresidente para establecer 2 v[a comunicaciones.
- Nota: El numero de telefono delresidente nunca se mostrara a los visitantes. Silos residentes estan usando eltelefono almismo tiempo que un visitante llama, la pantalla le indicara al visitante que la Ifnea esta ocupada.
- El residente responde a la llamada y conversa con el visitante para determinar si se le permitira el acceso.
- El residente puede usar el teclado de su telefonopara otorgar acceso presionando el numero Una vez otorgado el acceso, el sistema desconectara la llamada delvisitante y residente.
- El residente puede desconectar al visitante sin otorgaracceso presionando la tecla asterisco * o colgandola llamada.
