As most have seen, we have been going thru the testing phase of the gate and with any change in our community there is period of time for residents to adapt to change. The first week most of the holdup was the residents that did not go through the approval process to get the key card and as we were expecting the unauthorized residents are trying to figure out how they are going to get in or trying to figure out to cheat the system. The good part is that management has provided help at the gate and there are residents getting vetted to become legal residents. We need to understand that there is a very big problem with people living here that are not approved by management!! The residents that obey the rules and regulations and went through the proper approval to become Homeowners bought a home here to be in a 55+ community. We know that some residents can legally live here if approved if they are at least 40 but when we see all of the kids getting off school bus walk in

with back packs and 20-30 year olds driving in with or without kids and they don't leave at night that is not what the legal residents signed up for. Many of us love our children and grandchildren but they are not allowed to live here. The big problem with this is all of the parties keeping residents up at night or having friends coming and going all hours of the day and night with loud music and dangerous driving.

I know that I have talked about this many times before and will keep talking about it. I have seen way too many great people move from our community due to this problem and when I see people in the park renting out rooms to non-approved people or moving extended family in without approval, I feel that they are stealing from the approved residents. Sorry if sounds like a rant but sometimes things need to be said. I do want to wish everyone to be blessed with good health and happiness. Hope we get together at our activities again real soon.

"The Spy" by Danielle Steel – A review by Joan Stearns

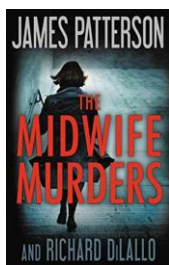
Did you know that - Hoorah!! - the SE Library is open every day, except Sunday, from 10 am - 6 PM.

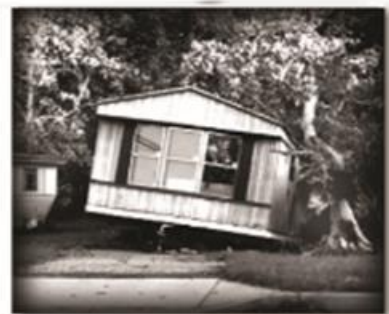

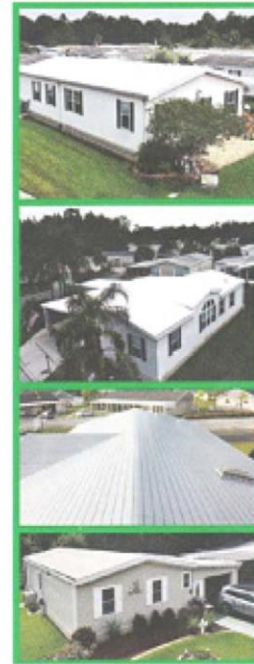
