We are also in dire need of book ends to hold the books. Do you have any you can donate? Please drop the off at the library or you can call Joan Sterns at 407-450-1723.



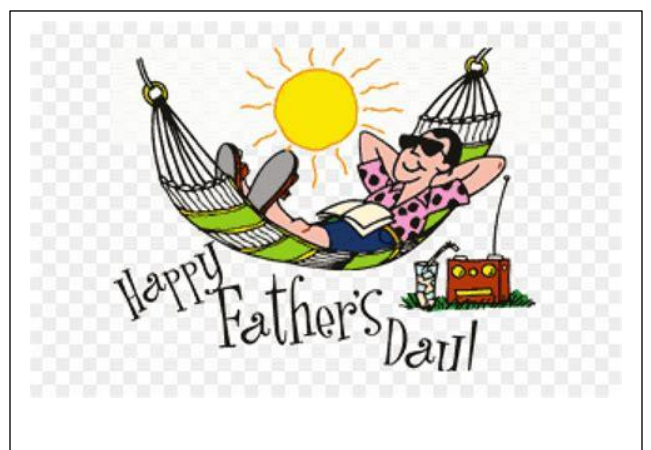

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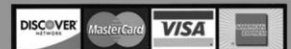

HOW DO WE STOP THE SPEEDERS? LET US COUNT THE WAYS

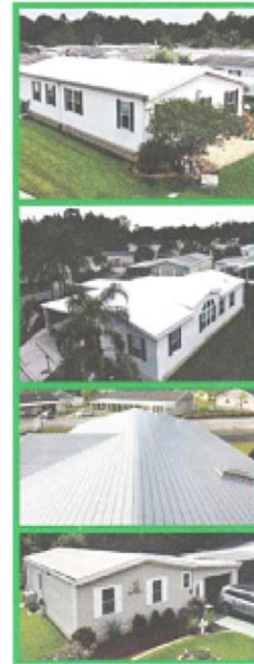
Hello everyone; I have had a successful Aortic Valve Replacement.
