The bottom line is that it's a lot of work for part-time management that is not out in our community to see what's going on and think it's the community's job to do what we pay for according to the contract the legal residents sign to live here. The gate and camera equipment we fought so hard for is worthless since the unauthorized residents just bully the community by blocking and backing up traffic till someone just waves them through or they just smash it. So much for the good of the camera equipment. So now it's easier to just say we are waiting on parts to fix it?? At least there is a security car with someone playing Pac-Man on their phone if not sleeping. I am going to get a town hall set up at our next HOA meeting this month. And we have been reaching out for outside help from our local government and media to come and give us some guidance. I hope to have a member of law enforcement there to a help answer questions or at least help us be more prepared for all of the dangerous activities in our community.

As a community we need to pull together and show unity to get our great community back to what it was and what we are paying a lot of money to enjoy and relax in our golden years. This is **NOT** a family park. It is a 55+ and school bus's stopping at our entrance is not part of 55+ other than a medical exception. Sorry, this is so long and angry but it's time to stand up and say this is not what we moved here for and pay for. Hope to see you soon.

STARLIGHT RANCH BURNS WHILE MIRTA FIDDLES

Hello everyone, I hope all is well. Due to current and ongoing events at Starlight Ranch, I have had to write a second article. I would like to write about some good things, but bad things are spiraling out of control. 1st I will update my recent adventure. I did finally get that meeting with Mirta, after having to wait weeks. It was not the face to face I had hoped for. She hid in her office and did it over the phone. She can't face the truth. I now have the names and addresses of the residents who threatened me because I reminded them of the rules. By the way Mirta didn't give the names to me, she's a coward and a liar. The police wanted me to press charges and I do have a file number. I have not decided when and if I will. Time will tell. I have also installed cameras around my house and God is watching too. I thank everyone for their support. Since my incident other residents have been threatened and menaced including Dawn, our HOA Vice President. We have also experienced horn blasting at us for going the speed limit, sworn at and given the finger. Residents are concerned for their safety and Mirta does nothing except to threaten residents with 10-day notices to clean up their property and remove their non-existent weeds and give us notices that our trash is out too soon, when we don't have a set schedule anymore. Don't worry Mirta's on top of it, as she peeks out her office door. It seems ELS has similar problems in other parks they mismanage, and they are being sued. We should band together and follow suit, to send them a message of unity. Also Join the HOA! Lastly, the most disturbing incident happened about midnight at the house at the corner of Ghetto Lane and Wild Horse Road. This same resident has had 37 Police calls in 3 years, including a 3-hour SWAT standoff/hostage situation. Now back to the midnight incident, there was a disturbance at that particular address on the corner. A possible drug deal gone wrong. Guns were fired, something you would expect to happen in the Pine Hills area, bullets went through Phil's house thank God Phil went to bed early that night because at least one bullet was found right where he was sitting earlier. Mirta's response was that it was just an isolated incident at Starlight. That house has had many such incidents and people still live there with multiple vehicles from different states. That is not counting the drug houses on Appaloosa and Horseshoe Bend, with druggies coming in and out all night. Are all those motorcycles coming in and out of here continuously also running drugs? Don't worry Mirta's on top of that too. She's in denial or is just too afraid to do anything about it. When Phil called and asked for a tarp to put on his roof after the bullet went through, she told him it was his responsibility. That's right, she's got us all covered. Why don't you hire some real security and get that gate working again. I'm not mad, I'm enraged. Do your job! God Bless every one of us and keep us safe,

DO I NEED A WEAPON FOR PROTECTION?

Hello everyone, I hope all is well on the home front. I recently had a meeting with HOA President, Curt. It was informal, in my living room. I have a good rapport with him, and he likes and condones my articles. Now I know there were many residents who were not happy to have him back as HOA President and I told him that. I personally think he is doing a great job in difficult times. Like me, he cares about Starlight and your wellbeing. He left the meeting with the Regional Manager, very angry. He is not working in good faith and will not accept any of our recent rule changes that would benefit all of us. I discussed some things the HOA could do but a lot of the issues we need Starlight and Regional Management to work with us on. We had a Police incident involving weapons. How many times has the gate been taken down? Are these people being prosecuted and are those cameras working? There was also an incident with teenagers disrupting the pool areas. We need guards here 24/7, One to man the gate at all times, build that guard shack, and one riding through the park, stopping speeders and issuing warnings. I hate to say this but the company that runs this place is just waiting us out, so they can replace us with younger residents. I received a call from Starlight manager Mirta, about residents not happy with me because I informed them about certain rule violations, I was told I was being threatened with bodily harm because they do not want to follow rules. Now bear in mind we have managers that do not enforce rules, which now is going to lead to violence. Why didn't they call the Police to end this problem? That would be the right thing to do. Obviously, she does not care about our health and safety. She would not give me the names of the residents who threatened me, causing my heart and monitor to go viral, and I had to hang up. The next day I got a harassment letter to cut back all my beautiful plants, trees and ornamental shrubs, power wash my house and was told my flowers were weeds, and only 10 days to do all this. I counted 12 weeds in ALL. It would seem the maintenance workers do not know the difference between a weed and annual and perennial. Then that same night, somebody snapped my American flagpole holder and broke it from the mount. I am a Marine disabled Vietnam Veteran, so how do you think that made me feel? I contacted the office, AGAIN, could not get a meeting with Mirta and was told everybody got that notice. Well, that is not true. I talked to many residents who did not get any letter of demand. Do not worry I will never use your names. There are over 100 residences in Starlight that did not get a notice. They are targeting certain people here. Do we need to consult a lawyer? I talked to the Police, so if anything happens to me, my wife or property, I will find out who it is. I will be installing cameras around my house. I also will be looking into getting a concealed carry permit to protect myself if necessary.
