Hello Starlight Ranch

As we know by looking at the calendar and realize that daylight is getting shorter each day the thought of fall is in the air. For many this is the start to their favorite time of year. The holidays are just around the corner and that means family gatherings cooler weather and more comfort food. Along with that comes that time of year when we as an HOA for Starlight Ranch need to take care of our corporate responsibility of an annual election and vote for new board members and take care of annual responsibilities. I cannot emphasize how important this is for our community and we need to have a lot more people that are homeowners to get involved with the HOA and possibly get a seat on the Board of directors to represent the whole community. I am reaching out to our wonderful Latino residents to step up and become more involved. I have always felt the balance of membership and board members has not been there. There are a lot of issues in our community that is a concern to all of us and I feel that balance should be more evenly balanced. As for me, one of the best tools that have been helpful has been having a seat for 7+ years on the Select committee of Networking for Progress that meets with the top CEO's of ELS that owns our park on a quarterly basis. We as a group have monthly meetings to compare issues and how they are dealt with at each park so that we can deal with those issues on the upper management level. Those meetings are to try and get a corporate agreement on dealing with issues that can help us on the local level. Also comparing stories with other ELS owned parks is helpful in knowing if issues here are on the corporate level or just the local park. This is my point on why the knowledge is so important. If you want to get involved in this year's election as a nominee or as a voting member you need to do so by the 5th of October to sign up before annual cutoff date. AM. Open to the public.




There are several seats available.



Spinach Madeline



This is a quick and easy recipe for a spinach side dish. It is creamy and cheesy and the seasoned bread crumbs give it a little crunch factor.

Prep: 5 mins

Cook: 30 mins

Total: 35 mins

Servings: 2

Yield: 2 servings



Ingredients

Topping:

2 teaspoons salted butter

¼ cup Italian-seasoned bread crumbs

Spinach:

- 1 (9 ounce) package frozen chopped spinach
- 2 tablespoons water
- ¼ cup evaporated milk, or as needed
- 2 tablespoons salted butter
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons chopped onion
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- ½ cup shredded jalapeno Jack cheese
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- ½ teaspoon red pepper flakes salt and ground black pepper to taste

Directions

Step 1

Melt butter in a skillet over low heat. Add bread crumbs. Cook and stir until butter is incorporated into the bread crumbs. Remove from skillet and set aside.

Step 2

Place spinach in a microwave-safe baking dish. Add water. Cover and cook on high for 7 1/2 minutes, stirring halfway through. Drain over a measuring cup. Add enough evaporated milk to make 1/2 cup. Set aside.

Step 3

Melt butter in the skillet. Add flour and cook, stirring continuously, until mixture turns paste-like. Add onion and cook, stirring constantly until soft and translucent, 4 to 5 minutes. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, about 1 minute. Slowly add milk mixture, stirring constantly. Mix in cheese, Worcestershire sauce, red pepper flakes, salt, and pepper. Add spinach and cook until well incorporated, 2 to 3 minutes.

Step 4

Set an oven rack about 6 inches from the heat source and preheat the oven's broiler.

Step 5

Place spinach mixture in a small greased baking dish, top with bread crumbs, and place under the broiler until bread crumbs are golden, about 5 minutes.
