IN-HOME CARE PROGRAM: We assist low-income, home bound seniors with daily living activities that have become difficult due to declining mobility and health in Orange and Seminole Counties.

<u>Care Management</u>: Clients receive a custom care plan coordinated by a case manager who monitors their needs on a regular basis.

Personal Care Assistance: Homebound clients receive general hygiene services such as bathing, shaving, and dressing.

Homemaker: Our homemakers provide light housekeeping and home management services such as laundry, shopping assistance, and meal preparation.

Companionship: Our companies relieve loneliness for isolated seniors by providing socialization, conversation, and assistance with reading and personal tasks such as running errands and shopping.

Respite Care: A certified personal care worker for your loved one is available to relieve caregivers for a few hours.
