VEHICLE RULES

Per Rules and regulations: TENANTS OR GUESTS ARE TO PARK THEIR VEHICLES ON THEIR OWN DRIVEWAY AND NOT IN THE STREETS OR ON THE LAWN. No more than 2 vehicles per home unit. If additional parking is needed for parties, etc., consult office for additional parking advice. Vehicles in the park must be licensed. Any vehicle not complying with the above will be removed from the park at the owner's expense.

NO MECHANICAL WORK ON VEHICLES SHALL BE PERMITTED NI THE PARK. The term vehicle shall include, but not limited to cars, Trucks, motorcycles, trailers, etc. No truck larger than a 3/4ton in size is permitted in the park except for deliveries. Anyone riding a motorcycle or motor bike in the park must wear a helmet

- 1. NO PARKING on the streets, empty lots, grass (even on your own lot/site grass) anytime for any reason!
- 2. No parking at the clubhouses or overflow parking lot AFTER MIDNIGHT.
- 3. Guests must adhere to the same rules and regulations. It's your RESPONSIBLITY to inform them of the Rules &Regulations.
- 4. Vehicles found in violation will be towed at OWNER'S EXPENSE NO EXECEPTIONS.
- 5. All vehicles must be registered/licensed or will be towed.
- 6. No mechanical work on vehicles shall be permitted in the community.
- 7. All residents and guests shall follow the community SPEED LIMITS AT ALL TIMES.
- 8. Music playing in vehicle must be turned down up entering and leaving the community per NOISE VIOLATIONS.
- 9. You must not park in someone else's driveway or-block sidewalks
- 10. Clubhouse parking is only for those that using our amenities and must have a resident permit. If you park more than 48 hours your vehicle will be towed
- 11. Overflow parking is used for the clubhouse gatherings and guests, not for residents residing in the park.

REGLAS DEL VEHÍCULO

Según las reglas y regulaciones: LOS INQUILINOS O INVITADOS DEBEN ESTACIONAR SUS VEHÍCULOS EN SU PROPIA ENTRADA Y NO EN LAS CALLES O EN EL CÉSPED. No más de 2 vehículos por unidad de vivienda. Si se necesita estacionamiento adicional para fiestas, etc., consulte con la oficina para obtener consejos adicionales sobre estacionamiento. Los vehículos en el parque deben tener licencia. Cualquier vehículo que no cumpla con lo anterior será retirado del parque por cuenta del propietario.

NO SE PERMITIRÁ NINGÚN TRABAJO MECÁNICO EN VEHÍCULOS EN EL PARQUE. El vehículo de trem incluirá, entre otros, automóviles. Camiones, motocicletas, remolques, etc. No se permiten camiones de más de 3/4 de tonelada de tamaño IA en el parque, excepto para entregas. Cualquier persona que circule en moto o moto por el parque deberá llevar casco.

- 1. NO ESTACIONARSE en las calles, lotes baldíos, césped (incluso en el césped de su propio lote/sitio) en ningún momento y por ningún motivo.
- 2. No se permite estacionar en la casa club ni en el estacionamiento adicional DESPUÉS DE LA MEDIANOCHE.
- 3. Los huéspedes deben cumplir con las mismas reglas y regulaciones. Es su RESPONSABILIDAD informarles sobre las reglas y regulaciones.
- 4. Los vehículos que se encuentren en infracción serán remolcados a COSTO DEL PROPIETARIO, SIN EXCEPCIONES.
- 5. Todos los vehículos deben estar registrados/licenciados o serán remolcados.
- 6. No se permitirán en la comunidad trabajos mecánicos en vehículos.
- 7. Todos los residentes e invitados deberán seguir los LÍMITES DE VELOCIDAD de la comunidad EN TODO MOMENTO.
- 8. La música que se reproduce en el vehículo debe bajarse al ingresar a la comunidad según VIOLACIONES DE RUIDO.
- 9. No debe estacionarse en el camino de entrada de otra persona ni bloquear las aceras.
- 10. El estacionamiento de la casa club es solo para aquellos que utilizan nuestras comodidades y deben tener un permiso de residente. Si estaciona más de 48 horas, su vehículo será remolcado.
- 11. El estacionamiento adicional es definitivamente para reuniones e invitados de la casa club, no para residentes que residen en el parque.

MEANING OF INDEPENDENCE DAY

Independence Day, known colloquially as the Fourth of July, is a federal holiday in the United States commemorating the Declaration of Independence, which was ratified by the Second Continental Congress on July 4, 1776, establishing the United States of America.

The Founding Father delegates of the Second Continental Congress declared that the Thirteen Colonies were no longer subject (and subordinate) to the monarch of Britain, King George III, and were now united, free, and independent states. ^[1] The Congress voted to approve independence by passing the Lee Resolution on July 2 and adopted the Declaration of Independence two days later, on July 4. ^[1]

Independence Day is commonly associated with fireworks, parades, barbecues, carnivals, fairs, picnics, concerts, [2] baseball games, family reunions, political speeches, and ceremonies, in addition to various other public and private events celebrating the history, government, and traditions of the United States.
