PRESIDENTS LETTER

Happy November to all Starlight residents. I am on my way to recovery and should be out of my collar by November 12th. Thanks for all the well wishes and all the help from everyone. I would like to give some updates on things going on in community. The back gate is waiting on transformer to be installed by Duke Energy, however they are backed up because of the Hurricane damage, once their caught up it will be placed on list for installation. The repairs to water system are ongoing and are currently in the survey process, that should take about 2 weeks, then new line will be placed under the road and will be a permanent fix. I also addressed issue with the mailbox and our mail. The electric issue stems from the transformer by the fence of tennis courts being shutdown so it could be relocated to other side of shuffle board courts, however when it was turned off it disabled more things than they expected, hence no power to mailbox room. The Orlando Utility Commission will place a transformer at present location soon as possible, again the Hurricane is effectively hurting us again. I have spoken with Mirta and Postmaster to resolve mail delivery soon as possible. The damaged house on Campfire and Wild Horse has

been condemned and electric turned off. The eviction process has begun. I also inquired about speed bump on Wild Horse and don't expect it till after first of year. Folks I want to encourage all to vote in upcoming board elections and encourage all to join the HOA. It has been a difficult month with everything going on. We are Starlight Strong. Thank you to all who helped neighbors and checked on neighbors thru difficult times. It just proves we can work together to build a better community. One last thing, thanks to all who stepped up during my absence, board and community. Thanks James Irvine President HOA

Feliz noviembre a todos los residentes de Starlight. Estoy en vías de recuperación y debería estar sin collarín el 12 de noviembre.Gracias por los buenos deseos y la ayuda de todos. Me gustaría dar algunas actualizaciones sobre las cosas que suceden en la comunidad.La puerta trasera está esperando que el transformador sea instalado por Duke Energy, sin embargo, se retrasaron debido a los daños del huracán, una vez que se pusieron al día se colocará en la lista para la instalación.Las reparaciones al sistema de agua están en curso y están actualmente en el proceso de los permisos, que debe tomar cerca de 2 semanas, entonces una nueva línea será colocada debajo del camino y será un arreglo permanente. También traté el tema del buzón y nuestro correo. El problema eléctrico se debe a que el transformador situado junto a la valla de las pistas de tenis quedó fuera de servicio para poder trasladarlo al otro lado de las pistas de shuffleboard, sin embargo, cuando desconectaron la electricidad deshabilitó más cosas de las que esperaban, de ahí que no llegara energía al cuarto de correo. La Comisión de Servicios Públicos de Orlando colocará un transformador en la ubicación actual tan pronto como sea posible, el huracán nos está perjudicando de nuevo. He hablado

con Mirta y el Postmaster para resolver la entrega de correo tan pronto como sea posible.La casa dañada en Campfire y Wild Horse ha sido condenada y la electricidad cortada. El proceso de desalojo ha comenzado. También pregunté por el badén en Wild Horse y no esperan resolverlo hasta después de primeros de año. Amigos, quiero animar a todos a votar en las próximas elecciones de la junta y animar a todos a unirse a la HOA. Ha sido un mes difícil con todo lo que está pasando. Somos Starlight Strong. Gracias a todos los que ayudaron a los vecinos y comprobado que los vecinos estuvieran bien en tiempos difíciles. Esto demuestra que podemos trabajar juntos para construir una comunidad mejor. Una última cosa, gracias a todos los que dieron un paso adelante durante mi ausencia, junta y comunidad. Gracias.




KAROAKE NIGHT!
