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Orange County Pet Laws.

This is a reminder for all Starlight Ranch dog owners of their responsibility for owning a dog in Orange County. The laws are in place for a reason. Some residents are not following the law and are being inconsiderate, rude as well as breaking the law.

Law – 4-1-45: Restraint of dogs states in part: “No person owning or having charge, care, custody, or control of any dog shall cause or permit, either willfully or through failure to exercise due care or control, any such dog to be upon any public property unless such dog be restrained by a substantial chain, or leash not exceeding six (6) feet in length, and is under the charge of a person competent to exercise care, custody, and control over such dog”.

You must keep your dog leashed anytime your dog is off your property. Your dog must be on a leash no longer than six (6) feet in length and in the care of a competent adult. There are designated ‘dog parks’ throughout Orange County that lawfully allow the absence of a leash.

Law-4-1-50: Dogs to be curbed states in part: “A person having custody of any dog shall not permit, either willfully or through failure to exercise due care or control, any such dog to defecate or urinate upon any public area, private property, County park or beach. **The person having custody of any dog shall immediately remove any feces deposited by such dog**”. Please clean up after your pet. BE A KIND NIEGHBOR.

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Leyes de Mascotas del Condado de Orange

Este es un recordatorio para todos los dueños de perros de Starlight Ranch sobre su responsabilidad de tener un perro en el Condado de Orange. Algunos residentes no están siguiendo la ley y están siendo desconsiderados, groseros y violando la ley.

La Ley-4-1-45: Restricción de perros establece en parte: "Ninguna persona que posea o tenga a cargo, cuidado, custodia o control de un perro causará o permitirá, ya sea deliberadamente o por no ejercer el debido cuidado o control, cualquier dicho perro debe estar en cualquier propiedad pública a menos que dicho perro esté sujeto por una cadena sustancial o una correa que no exceda los (6) pies de largo y esté bajo el cuidado de una persona competente para ejercer el cuidado de una persona competente para ejercer el cuidado, la custodia y el control de dicho perro". Debe mantener a su perro con correa cada vez que su perro esté fuera de su propiedad. Su perro debe estar con una correa de no más (6) pies de largo y bajo el cuidado de un adulto competente. Hay "parques para perros" designados en todo el Condado de Orange que permiten legalmente la ausencia de correa.

La Ley-4-1-50: Perros que deben controlarse establece en parte: "Una persona que tenga la custodia de cualquier perro no permitirá, ya sea deliberadamente o por no ejercer el debido cuidado o control, que dicho perro defaque u urine en cualquier lugar público". área, propiedad privada, parque del Condado o playa. La persona que tenga la custodia de cualquier perro deberá retirar inmediatamente cualquier excremento depositado por dicho perro" Por favor, limpiar los desechos de su mascota. Ser un vecino amable
