MONDAY OCTOBER 12TH IS COLUMBUS DAY

Just a reminder that it is a Federal Holiday so Banks and Federal Agencies will be closed.

Columbus Day is a U.S. federal holiday commemorating Christopher Columbus's arrival in the Americas in 1492, marking the start of permanent European contact with the Western Hemisphere. The holiday also serves to celebrate Italian and Italian-American cultural heritage, but has become controversial due to the tragic impact Columbus's voyages had on Indigenous populations, leading many places to replace it with Indigenous Peoples' Day. October 12, 1492, is of enormous significance in Western history: It is the day when explorer Christopher Columbus completed his journey across the Atlantic Ocean and landed in the "New World." What Columbus actually reached on that October day was an island he named San Salvador that is now part of the Bahamas.


